Mayor Moccia has called a meeting of 5 mile river residents who wish to make repairs to the river banks now. He would expedite permits. Next step is hiring firm to do the study. WNA will be involved to insure repairs done correctly. Will also recommend they look at 1990 study as well.

Charles and Bob recommended a river clean up. Bob will contact the city for assistance and procedures.

William was unable to attend the CNNA meeting but will attend the next one. Bob said that the CNNA are looking at surveys distributed at primary day to see priority of issues concerning Norwalk residents.
